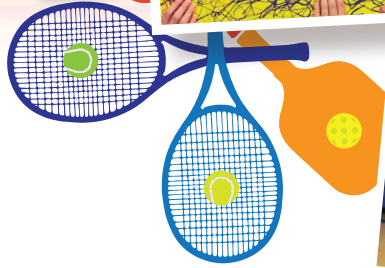

### The Pocantico Hills Day Camp

has a full schedule of activities and events lined up for this summer, including day trips to exciting destinations, on-campus activities like gaga ball and the inflatable water slide, swim lessons and free swim, cooking classes, camp outs, and wilderness walks on the beautiful Rockefeller trails that surround our campus.

We welcome students who are entering pre-kindergarten (must have turned 4 by July 1st. Graduates of the Pocantico JPK program are exempt from the age restriction) through rising ninth-graders. Rising 10th-graders can work as counselors-in-training and have the camp fee waived as compensation.

Campers are placed in one of three divisions: primary (pre-kindergarten through grade 2), intermediate (grades 3-6), and middle school (grade 7 and teens).

Our specialists enrich our camp offerings in the following areas: arts and crafts, primary athletics, secondary athletics, studio, culinary, wilderness and racket sports.

#### Please note:

- The camp provides transportation for in-district children for the regular camp day. Transportation is not provided for the change to early arrival and late pick-up programs.
- The camp will be closed on July 4 in observance of Independence Day.
- Additional fees will apply for selected teen trips.
